

## Bella, Bunny \& Bear Quilt 1

Designed and made by Sally Ablett Size of quilt 50 " $\times 58$ " - unfinished block size $91 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 91 / 2$ "size

## Requirements

Fabrics from the Bella, Bunny \& Bear collection

1. A647.1-3-inch nursery squares pink 3/4yd
2. A646.2 - Yellow check - $3 / 8 y d$
3. A645.3 - Bella \& bear on natural 3/8yd
4. A648.1 - Alphabet on cream - 3/8yd
5. A649.3 - Bella \& bear faces on dark grey - 3/8yd
6. BB307-Light blue $-1 \frac{1}{4}$ yds
7. BB40-Cream - $5 / 8 \mathrm{yd}$ Wadding and backing $54 " \mathrm{x} 62$ "

All measurements include $1 / 4$ " seam allowances; press each seam as you go. you will need to join your strips to get the length on the border.

## Cutting

From fabric 1 cut
$13 \times 7 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $7 \frac{1}{2}$ " (block 1 )
From each of the fabrics 2, 3, 4 and 5 cut $12 \times 23 / 4 " \times 5 "$ (block 2 )
$12 \times 233 / 4 \times 23 / 4$ " (block 2)
$6 \times 41 / 2 " \times 41 / 2 "$ (border top \& bottom)
From fabric 6 cut
$6 \times 11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF (outer border)
$26 \times 1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 71 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ (sides of block 1 )
$26 \times 1 / 22^{\prime \prime} \times 91 / 2 "$ (top \& bottom of block 1)
From fabric 7 cut
$5 \times 11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF (inner border)

## Making up the blocks

## Block 1

Lay out the fabric pieces as in block 1 diagram. Stitch the side strips to each side of the center square. Next add the top and bottom strips to complete the block. You need 13 in total.
Block 2
Sew the two small square together to made a rectangle and then stitch to the two rectangles together to made a square.


Lay out of the first three rows.

Make the other three in the same way. Stitch the top two together and the bottom two. Now sew the two strips together to make the square. 12 blocks in total.

## Making up quilt center

Lay out all the blocks as in the main diagram. Stitch in rows, top row pressing the seams to the right. On the next row, press to the left. This will help when sewing the rows together.

## Inner border

Join your strips to get the length
Sides - $2 \times 2$ " x $45^{1} 2^{\prime \prime}$--Top \& bottom - 2 x $2^{\prime \prime}$ x $481 / 2 "$
Stitch the sides to the quilt center and then the top \& bottom

## Top \& bottom middle border strips

Sew 12 square in length as in the main diagram together for the top \& bottom. Stitch to quilt.

## Outer border

Join your strips to get the length
Sides - $2 \times 1$ x $566^{1 / 2 "}$-- Top \& bottom - $2 \times 11 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ x 450/2"
Stitch the sides to the quilt center and then the top \& bottom

## Quilting

Sandwich the quilt top, wadding and backing together.
Quilt by hand or machine as desired. Trim the backing and wadding to size of quilt.

## Requirements

Fabrics from the Bella, Bunny \& Bear collection

1. A647.3-3-inch nursery squares yellow - $3 / 4 y d$
2. A646.3 - Pale Blue check $-3 / 8 y d$
3. A645.2 - Bella \& bear on pink $-3 / 8 y d$
4. A648.3 - Alphabet on dark grey - 3/8yd
5. A649.2 - Bella \& bear faces on yellow 3/8yd
6. BB40-Cream - $1 \frac{1}{4}$ yds -
7. BB306-Bella Pink - $5 / 8 y d$ Wadding and backing 54" x 62"

All measurements include $1 / 4$ " seam allowances; press each seam as you go. you will need to join your strips to get the length on the border.

## Cutting

From fabric 1 cut
$13 \times 7 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $7 \frac{1}{2}$ " (block 1 )
From each of the fabrics 2, 3, 4 and 5 cut
$12 \times 23 / 4 " \times 5$ " (block 2 )
$12 \times 233 / 4 \times 23 / 4 "$ (block 2)
$6 \times 41 / 2 " \times 41 / 2 "$ (border top \& bottom)
From fabric 6 cut
$6 \times 11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF (outer border)
$26 \times 1 \frac{1}{2} " \times 71 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ (sides of block 1)
$26 \times 1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $91 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ (top \& bottom of block 1)
From fabric 7 cut
$5 \times 11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF (inner border)

## Making up the blocks

## Block 1

Lay out the fabric pieces as in block 1 diagram. Stitch the side strips to each side of the center square. Next add the top and bottom strips to complete the block. You need 13 in total.
Block 2
Sew the two small square together to made a rectangle and then stitch to the two rectangles together to made a square.

## Making up quilt center

Sides - $2 \times 2$ " x $45^{1 ⁄ 2} 2^{\prime \prime}--T o p ~ \& ~ b o t t o m ~-~ 2 ~ x ~ 2 " ~ x ~$ $481 / 2 "$
Stitch the sides to the quilt center and then the top \& bottom

## Top \& bottom middle border strips

Sew 12 square in length as in the main diagram together for the top \& bottom. Stitch to quilt.

## Outer border

Join your strips to get the length
Sides - $2 \times 1$ x $566^{1 / 2 "}$-- Top \& bottom - $2 \times 11 / 2 "$ x 450 $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
Stitch the sides to the quilt center and then the top \& bottom

## Quilting

Sandwich the quilt top, wadding and backing together.
Quilt by hand or machine as desired. Trim the backing and wadding to size of quilt.


Bella, Bunny \& Bear Quilt 3

## Requirements

Fabrics from the Bella, Bunny \& Bear collection

1. A647.2-3-inch nursery squares blue - 3/4yd
2. A646.1 - Pink check - $3 / 8 \mathrm{yd}$
3. A645.1 - Bella \& bear on cream $-3 / 8 y d$
4. A648.2 - Alphabet on natural - 3/8yd
5. A649.1 - Bella \& bear faces on pale blue - $3 / 8 y d$
6. BB304-Soft yellow $-1 \frac{1}{4} \mathrm{yd}$
7. BB94-Light grey $-5 / 8 y d$ Wadding and backing 54" x 62 "

All measurements include $1 / 4$ " seam allowances; press each seam as you go. you will need to join your strips to get the length on the border.

## Cutting

From fabric 1 cut
$13 \times 7 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 7 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ (block 1)
From each of the fabrics 2, 3, 4 and 5 cut $12 \times 23 / 4 " \times 5 "$ (block 2 )
$12 \times 233 / 4 \times 23 / 4 "$ (block 2 )
$6 \times 41 / 2 " \times 41 / 2 "$ (border top \& bottom)
From fabric 6 cut
$6 \times 11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF (outer border)
$26 \times 1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 7^{1 / 2 "}$ (sides of block 1)
$26 \times 1 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 9^{1 / 2 "}($ top \& bottom of block 1)
From fabric 7 cut
$5 \times 11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF (inner border)

## Making up the blocks

## Block 1

Lay out the fabric pieces as in block 1 diagram. Stitch the side strips to each side of the center square. Next add the top and bottom strips to complete the block. You need 13 in total.

Stitch the sides to the quilt center and then the top \& bottom

## Top \& bottom middle border strips

Sew 12 square in length as in the main diagram together for the top \& bottom. Stitch to quilt.

## Outer border

Join your strips to get the length
Sides - $2 \times 1$ x $566^{1 / 2 "}$-- Top \& bottom - $2 \times 11 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ x 450/2"
Stitch the sides to the quilt center and then the top \& bottom

## Quilting

Sandwich the quilt top, wadding and backing together.
Quilt by hand or machine as desired. Trim the backing and wadding to size of quilt.
