



Bella, Bunny & Bear Quilt 1

Designed and made by Sally Ablett Size of quilt 50" x 58" - unfinished block size $9^{1/2}$ " x $9^{1/2}$ "size

Requirements

Fabrics from the Bella, Bunny & Bear collection

- 1. A647.1 3-inch nursery squares pink 3/4yd
- 2. A646.2 Yellow check 3/8yd
- 3. A645.3 Bella & bear on natural 3/8yd
- 4. A648.1 Alphabet on cream 3/8yd
- 5. A649.3 Bella & bear faces on dark grey 3/8yd
- 6. BB307 Light blue -11/4yds
- 7. BB40 Cream 5/8yd

Wadding and backing 54" x 62"

All measurements include ¼" seam allowances; press each seam as you go. you will need to join your strips to get the length on the border.



Block 1

Cutting

From fabric 1 cut
13 x 7½" x 7½" (block 1)
From each of the fabrics 2, 3, 4 and 5 cut
12 x 2¾" x 5" (block 2)
12 x 2¾" x 2¾" (block 2)
6 x 4½" x 4½" (border top & bottom)
From fabric 6 cut
6 x 1½" x WOF (outer border)
26 x 1½" x 7½" (sides of block 1)
26 x 1½" x 9½" (top & bottom of block 1)
From fabric 7 cut

Making up the blocks

5 x 1½" x WOF (inner border)

Block 1

Lay out the fabric pieces as in block 1 diagram. Stitch the side strips to each side of the center square. Next add the top and bottom strips to complete the block. You need 13 in total.

Block 2

Sew the two small square together to made a rectangle and then stitch to the two rectangles together to made a square.



Block 2



Lay out of the first three rows.

Make the other three in the same way. Stitch the top two together and the bottom two. Now sew the two strips together to make the square. 12 blocks in total.

Binding

Use your favorite method from fabric 6 to bind the quilt.









Block 2 made up of four parts

Making up quilt center

Lay out all the blocks as in the main diagram. Stitch in rows, top row pressing the seams to the right. On the next row, press to the left. This will help when sewing the rows together.

Inner border

Join your strips to get the length Sides - 2 x 2" x 45½" --Top & bottom - 2 x 2" x 48½"

Stitch the sides to the quilt center and then the top & bottom

Top & bottom middle border strips

Sew 12 square in length as in the main diagram together for the top & bottom. Stitch to quilt.

Outer border

Join your strips to get the length Sides - 2 x 1" x 56½" -- Top & bottom - 2 x 1½" x 450½"


Stitch the sides to the quilt center and then the top & bottom

Quilting

Sandwich the quilt top, wadding and backing together.

Quilt by hand or machine as desired. Trim the backing and wadding to size of quilt.





Bella, Bunny & Bear Quilt 2

Designed and made by Sally Ablett Size of quilt 50" x 58" - unfinished block size $9^{1/2}$ " x $9^{1/2}$ "size

Requirements

Fabrics from the Bella, Bunny & Bear collection

- 1. A647.3 3-inch nursery squares yellow 3/4yd
- 2. A646.3 Pale Blue check 3/8yd
- 3. A645.2 Bella & bear on pink 3/8yd
- 4. A648.3 Alphabet on dark grey 3/8yd
- 5. A649.2 Bella & bear faces on yellow 3/8yd
- 6. BB40 Cream -11/4yds -
- 7. BB306 Bella Pink 5/8yd

Wadding and backing 54" x 62"

All measurements include ¼" seam allowances; press each seam as you go. you will need to join your strips to get the length on the border.



From fabric 1 cut 13 x 7½" x 7½" (block 1)

From each of the fabrics 2, 3, 4 and 5 cut

12 x 2¾" x 5" (block 2)

12 x 2¾" x 2¾" (block 2)

6 x 41/2" x 41/2" (border top & bottom)

From fabric 6 cut

6 x 1½" x WOF (outer border)

26 x 1½" x 7½" (sides of block 1)

26 x 1½" x 9½" (top & bottom of block 1)

From fabric 7 cut

5 x 1½" x WOF (inner border)

Making up the blocks

Block 1

Lay out the fabric pieces as in block 1 diagram. Stitch the side strips to each side of the center square. Next add the top and bottom strips to complete the block. You need 13 in total.

Block 2

Sew the two small square together to made a rectangle and then stitch to the two rectangles together to made a square.

Lay out of the first three rows.

Make the other three in the same way. Stitch the top two together and the bottom two. Now sew the two strips together to make the square. 12 blocks in total.

Binding

Use your favorite method from fabric 6 to bind the quilt.









Block 2 made up of four parts

Making up quilt center

Lay out all the blocks as in the main diagram. Stitch in rows, top row pressing the seams to the right. On the next row, press to the left. This will help when sewing the rows together.

Inner border

Join your strips to get the length Sides - 2 x 2" x 45½" --Top & bottom - 2 x 2" x 48½"

Stitch the sides to the quilt center and then the top & bottom

Top & bottom middle border strips

Sew 12 square in length as in the main diagram together for the top & bottom. Stitch to quilt.

Outer border

Join your strips to get the length Sides - 2 x 1" x $56\frac{1}{2}$ " -- Top & bottom - 2 x $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $450\frac{1}{2}$ "

Stitch the sides to the quilt center and then the top & bottom

Quilting

Sandwich the quilt top, wadding and backing together.

Quilt by hand or machine as desired. Trim the backing and wadding to size of quilt.





Bella, Bunny & Bear Quilt 3

Designed and made by Sally Ablett Size of quilt 50" x 58" - unfinished block size $9^{1/2}$ " x $9^{1/2}$ "size

Requirements

Fabrics from the Bella, Bunny & Bear collection

- 1. A647.2 3-inch nursery squares blue 3/4yd
- 2. A646.1 Pink check 3/8yd
- 3. A645.1 Bella & bear on cream 3/8yd
- 4. A648.2 Alphabet on natural 3/8yd
- 5. A649.1 Bella & bear faces on pale blue 3/8yd
- 6. BB304 Soft yellow -11/4yds
- 7. BB94 Light grey 5/8yd

Wadding and backing 54" x 62"

All measurements include ¼" seam allowances; press each seam as you go. you will need to join your strips to get the length on the border.



Block 1

Cutting

From fabric 1 cut 13 x 7½" x 7½" (block 1)

From each of the fabrics 2, 3, 4 and 5 cut

12 x 2¾" x 5" (block 2)

12 x 23/4" x 23/4" (block 2)

6 x 4½" x 4½" (border top & bottom)

From fabric 6 cut

6 x 1½" x WOF (outer border)

26 x 1½" x 7½" (sides of block 1)

26 x 1½" x 9½" (top & bottom of block 1)

From fabric 7 cut

5 x 1½" x WOF (inner border)

Making up the blocks

Block 1


Lay out the fabric pieces as in block 1 diagram. Stitch the side strips to each side of the center square. Next add the top and bottom strips to complete the block. You need 13 in total.

Block 2

Sew the two small square together to made a rectangle and then stitch to the two rectangles together to made a square.

Lay out of the first three rows.

Make the other three in the same way. Stitch the top two together and the bottom two. Now sew the two strips together to make the square. 12 blocks in total.

Binding

Use your favorite method from fabric 6 to bind the quilt.

Making up quilt center

Inner border

Join your strips to get the length Sides - 2 x 2" x 45½" --Top & bottom - 2 x 2" x 48½"

Stitch the sides to the quilt center and then the top & bottom

Top & bottom middle border strips

Sew 12 square in length as in the main diagram together for the top & bottom. Stitch to quilt.

Outer border

Join your strips to get the length Sides - 2 x 1" x 56½" -- Top & bottom - 2 x 1½" x 450½"

Stitch the sides to the quilt center and then the top & bottom

Quilting

Sandwich the quilt top, wadding and backing together.

Quilt by hand or machine as desired. Trim the backing and wadding to size of quilt.
