FABRIC REQUIREMENTS (Bunny Garden Collection)

DESIGN 1

Fabric 1: ⅝yd - 60cm - A146.1 (Bunny wreath white)
Fabric 2: ⅜yd - 30cm - A147.3 (Pretty flowers on denim)
Fabric 3: ⅝yd - 60cm - A148.2 (Bunny adventure on pale green)
Fabric 4: ⅜yd - 30cm - A149.3 (Butterflies on sunshine)
Fabric 5: ⅜yd - 30cm - A150.1 (Leo bunny on light grey)
Fabric 6: ⅝yd - 60cm - BB68 (Spring green)
Fabric 7: 1¼yd - 1¼mtr - BB65 (Light flamingo)
56" square wadding
56" square backing

DESIGN 2

Fabric 1: ⅝yd - 60cm - A146.2 (Bunny wreath on light grey)
Fabric 2: ⅜yd - 30cm - A147.2 (Pretty flowers on pink)
Fabric 3: ⅝yd - 60cm - A148.1 (Bunny adventure on white)
Fabric 4: ⅜yd - 30cm - A149.2 (Butterflies on pink)
Fabric 5: ⅜yd - 30cm - A150.3 (Leo bunny on yellow)
Fabric 6: ⅝yd - 60cm - BB40 (Off white)
Fabric 7: 1¼yd - 1¼mtr - BB60 (Grey linen)
56" square wadding
56" square backing

DESIGN 3

Fabric 1: ⅝yd - 60cm - A146.3 (Bunny wreath sunshine)
Fabric 2: ⅜yd - 30cm - A147.1 (Pretty flowers on white)
Fabric 3: ⅝yd - 60cm - A148.3 (Bunny adventure on denim)
Fabric 4: ⅜yd - 30cm - A149.1 (Butterflies on white)
Fabric 5: ⅜yd - 30cm - A150.2 (Leo bunny on pink)
Fabric 6: ⅝yd - 60cm - BB40 (Off white)
Fabric 7: 1¼yd - 1¼mtr - BB68 (Spring green)
56" square wadding
56" square backing

CUTTING

Cut across width of fabric.

- 1.** From fabric 1 cut:
 - 12 x 6⁷/₈" x 6⁷/₈" cut in half diagonally once (cut from bottom left to top right)
 - 2.** From fabric 2 cut:
 - 25 x 3¹/₂" x 3¹/₂"
 - 3.** From fabric 3 cut:
 - 12 x 6⁷/₈" x 6⁷/₈" cut in half diagonally once (cut from bottom left to top right)
 - 4.** From fabric 4 cut:
 - 25 x 3¹/₂" x 3¹/₂"
 - 5.** From fabric 5 cut:
 - 25 x 3¹/₂" x 3¹/₂"
 - 6.** From fabric 6 cut:
 - 2 x 1¹/₂" x 45¹/₂" (join fabric)
 - 2 x 1¹/₂" x 47¹/₂" (join fabric)
 - 7.** From fabric 7 cut:
 - 2 x 3" x 47¹/₂" (join fabric)
 - 2 x 3" x 52¹/₂" (join fabric)
- 50 x 3⁷/₈" x 3⁷/₈" cut in half diagonally once

MAKING UP BLOCK

Use ¼" seam allowance throughout. Press all seams open unless otherwise noted

Lay out all the fabric pieces for each of the blocks

On block 1 you will have fabric 1 in the top left hand corner with fabric 3 in the bottom right corner, and on block 2 fabric 3 will be in the top left and fabric 1 in the bottom right corner

Start by sewing in rows the top triangle of fabric 7 to the square of fabric 5. Press your seam to the right

Next sew the triangle of fabric 7 to the square of fabric 2 and then the triangle of fabric 7 together. This time press your seam to the left

Then sew the last square of fabric 4 to the triangle of fabric 7. Press again to the right this will help when you sew rows together

Sew the rows together and then add the larger triangles of fabric 1 and fabric 3 to each side of the panel to make the block

Sewing 25 blocks in total

MAKING UP QUILT

Lay out all the blocks as in the diagram above

Sew the rows together pressing the seams of each row in the opposite way each time. This will help when you sew the rows together

Sew the rows together

When you have all your blocks sewn together add the inner borders of fabric 6

Sew the sides and then the top and bottom

Now add the outer border again sides and then the top and bottom of fabric 7

Sandwich together the quilt top, wadding and backing

Quilt by hand or machine as desired

BINDING

Use your favourite method from fabric 7 to bind the quilt
